



2014 Chromebook Solution RFP Award

On July 14, the Rhode Island Society of Technology Educators (RISTE) and the Northern Rhode Island Collaborative issued a joint cooperative procurement Request For Proposals (RFP) to provide a volume price agreement and fulfillment service for Chromebooks and related products.

We sought proposals from authorized Chromebook providers who could serve our consortium members with <u>competitive pricing</u> and <u>quality service</u>. Our goal was for every member's Google implementation to be a success.

RISTE was looking for a solution-based initiative rather than a commodity based contract. Although selecting single components of the solution is an option, proposals were evaluated on how well they provided a complete implementation solution, including various options. The following criteria were evaluated:

- Competitive pricing
- Coordination of the entire project process
- Project management
- Deployment
- Ongoing support

Six qualified vendors submitted proposals which were scored using the following:

Quality of Response – 20 points, Adherence to specifications – 10 points, Quality of References – 10 points Warranty and service – 10 points, and Pricing – 50 points

On September 17, the RISTE board of directors, acting on the recommendation of the RFP review committee, awarded the Chromebook Solution RFP 2014 to CDW-G.
